A.20-04-013: Email Ruling Granting Alameda Municipal Power and Northern California Power Agency's Motions to Exclude Evidence

On October 6, 2020, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) sent an email request to the Service List for Application (A.) 20-04-013 seeking to include two documents from Federal Energy Regulatory (FERC) Proceeding Docket No. EL20-63 in the record for this proceeding. The documents PG&E requested to include in the record of A.20-04-013 are:

- *Answer of Pacific Gas and Electric Company to Petition for Declaratory Order and Complaint of the City of Alameda and Request for Expedited Dismissal* (PG&E FERC Answer), dated September 9, 2020; and,
- *Motion for Leave to File Reply and Reply of Pacific Gas and Electric Company* (PG&E FERC Motion & Reply), dated September 30, 2020.

PG&E filed the FERC Answer and FERC Reply in the FERC proceeding in response to a *Petition for Declaratory Order and Complaint of the City of Alameda (AMP Filing)* filed by AMP before FERC, dated August 10, 2020.

On October 12, 2020, Alameda Municipal Power (AMP) filed a *Motion to Oppose PG&E's October 6, 2020 Request to Enter Documents into the Record* (AMP Motion) in A.20-04-013. Also on October 12, 2020, the Northern California Power Agency (NCPA) filed a *Motion to Strike Exhibits and/or Opposition to Request for Official Notice of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's Filings in Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Docket EL20-63-000* (NCPA Motion).

The AMP and NCPA Motions are granted. The PG&E FERC Answer and PG&E FERC Motion & Reply are not entered into evidence or otherwise included in the record of this proceeding. We concur with AMP and NCPA that PG&E had the opportunity to include the arguments, testimony and other components of its Answer and Motion & Reply in its August 31, 2020 Rebuttal Testimony but did not. Further, we do not agree that the PG&E Answer and Motion & Reply are essential to providing context and information regarding the issues in the scope of this proceeding.
